

DACC Course & Schedule Abbreviations

(for Course Sections, Buildings, Rooms, & Instructional Methods)

SECTION CODES:

Each course taught (ex: <u>ENGL 101</u>) will have a section with it (ex: <u>ENGL 101 A</u>). The letters refer to the time of day the section is taught (A= within the 8:00 hour). We also have several other section codes that refer to something specific. Listed below are some of the most commonly used codes:

On-Campus Section Codes:

A = 8:00/8:30 am Section

B = 9:00/9:30 am Section

C = 10:00/10:30 am Section

D = 11:00/11:30 am Section

E = 12:00/12:30 pm Section

F = 1:00/1:30 pm Section

G = 2:00/2:30 pm Section

H = 3:00/3:30 pm Section

I = 4:00/4:30 pm Section

_R = Early Ending Section

_Z = Late Start Section
