NOTES: IMPORTANT DUAL CREDIT EXCEPTIONAL FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE NOTES

- Each exceptional freshman and sophomore student will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Students must complete a DACC application.
- Student must turn in high school transcript.
- Student must turn in SAT/ACT or take DACC Placement.
- Developmental Courses DEVE 098, DEVR 098 & 099, DEVM 098, 099, 100; GSCI 100 and MATH 108 CANNOT be completed for dual credit.
- **One Time \$80 Assessment Fee for Freshman & Sophomore students who meet the placement requirements and who enroll in a Dual Credit course.**
- Students for Dual Credit will be charged 50% tuition and 50% technology/activity fees and 100% of course applicable fees except for the College's online course fee (\$65) which is waived for all dual credit students for courses taught by a DACC Instructor either on campus, at your high school or online.
- Students are responsible for the course textbooks/Follett Access (Included).

SECTION A: DACC DUAL CREDIT EXCEPTIONAL RULES

- DACC will consider exceptional freshman and sophomore students who demonstrate readiness for college-level coursework through the Colleges' established institutional policies.
- Each freshman and sophomore student will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Additionally, the student will be required to present the following information to be considered:
 - Completed "Request for Early Admittance to Dual Credit Program" form
 - Proof of placement into ENGL 101 and MATH 107**

The DACC Placement test, ACT, SAT or High School Transcript can all be used for proof of placement.
