4 EASY STEPS TO SUCCESS

- 1.) Attend DACC for all of the required General Education courses and the DACC Nursing Program courses.
- 2.) Submit a provisional application to enroll in the RN to BSN program at EIU while in the DACC Nursing Program, taking classes from both schools at the same time.
- 3.) Graduate from DACC and pass the NCLEX national licensure exam.
- 4.) Finish one year of online coursework needed to earn a Bachelor's in Nursing from EIU.



THE 3 + 1 STORY

In what are commonly known as 3 + 1 programs, participants complete the first three years of classes at DACC, and then complete the final year's credits online from the transfer institution.

DACC has partnerships for specific programs with two senior institutions, Franklin University and Eastern Illinois University (EIU).

DACC has established a "Bachelor's Lounge" computer lab on campus for fourth year students who need access to technology for their coursework.



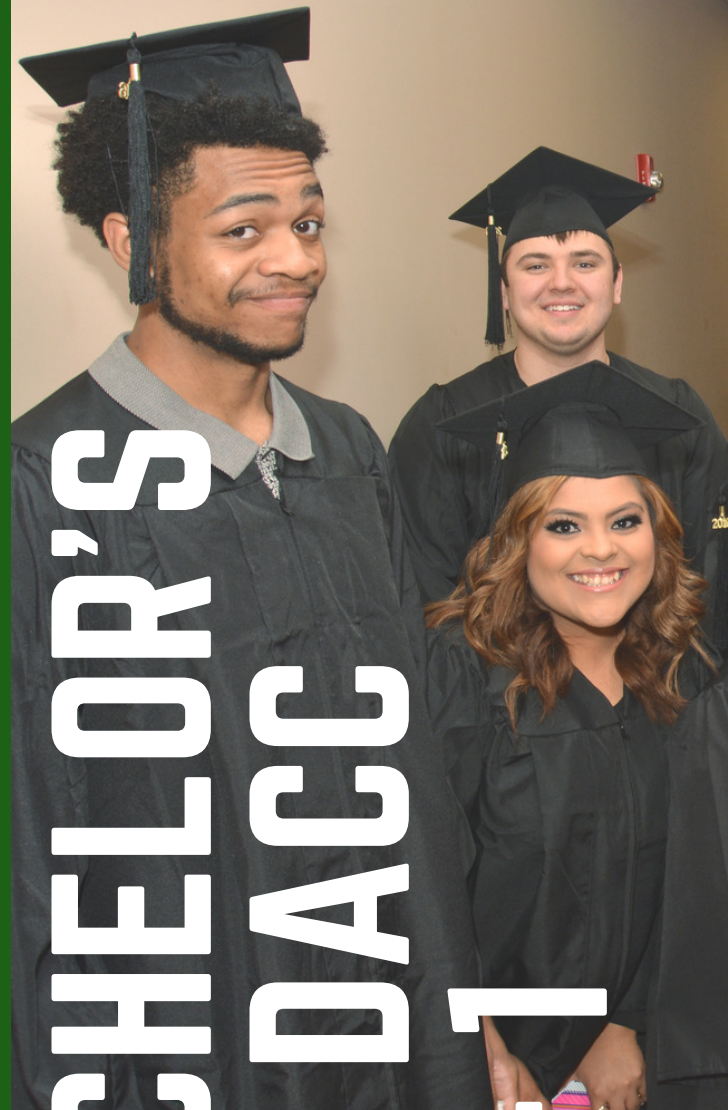
