DACC offers courses that prepare you for your GED. We also offer Basic Skills classes in reading, writing and arithmetic for people who have their high school diploma, but still need a little extra help.

DACC makes class enrollment Free, Fast, and Friendly. Just follow these **4** steps:

1. Submit a completed application to the Admissions/Registration Office.

You will find an application on the web at www.dacc.cc.il.us, or you may call **217.443.DACC** (217.443.8701 TDD/TTY) and ask to have one sent to you. Official transcripts from previously attended colleges/universities should also be forwarded to the DACC Records Office.

2. Attend a new student orientation.

Call **217.443.8708** to sign up for orientation. This will answer a lot of your questions and get you started on the right foot.

3. Take the placement test.

Some courses require placement testing prior to enrollment. Call **217.443.8708** to sign up.

4. Register for Classes!

Students who plan on pursuing a degree, transferring credits to another school, or want to attend full-time should see an Academic Advisor or Counselor. Appointments are recommended, but walk-ins are also welcome. Call **217.443.8750** to schedule an appointment. Part-time students may register through the Admissions/Registration office via phone, **217.443.8800**, or in person. Walk-ins are welcome.
