Notes:

- 1. College of Liberal Arts students must complete one year of college foreign language regardless of high school foreign language.
- 2. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
- 3. Capstone available. SIUC offers the only ABA approved Bachelors paralegal program in Illinois.
- 4. The paralegal program offers two tracks: 1) general track for those seeking a profession as a respected paralegal; 2) pre-law specialization for those seeking admission to law school.
- 5. HIST 182 is taught as needed and is recommended to meet the SIU international coursework requirement. Must also complete a multicultural requirement. Choose from ANTH 103, ANTH 107, SOCY 200, LITR 106, MUSI 120, SOCY 225, or SPCH 141. If not taken at DACC, student may have to take at SIU.
- 6. If transferring without an Associate's degree, must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts in order to satisfy SIU's core curriculum.
