#### **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

- 1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).
- 2. Interested students must complete the Social Work Program Application materials and have a personal interview with a member of the faculty.
- 3. Complete SOCY 202 Intro to Social Work.
- 4. Complete or be registered in PSYC 100, SOCY 100, POLI 150, and PHIL elective

### **Admission Criteria for Department of Social Work**

#### (Admission to the University does not guarantee admission into this program.)

In order to be accepted as a major in the Bachelor of Social Work degree program, students must satisfy the following requirements.

- 1. Cumulative GPS of 2.0 or higher.
- 2. Must earn a grade of C or better in SOCY 202.
- 3. Highly recommended to have volunteer service hours or work in a human services setting within the past three years. Such settings include churches, summer programs, senior citizen centers, hospitals, etc. 100 hours is required prior to completion of WIU's SW440.
- 4. Critical thinking and writing skills as demonstrated in coursework and application essays.
- 5. Interpersonal skills as demonstrated in the classroom, and group interaction and faculty interview.
- 6. Successful completion of all components of the major application process by the due dates.

#### Notes:

- 1. Recommended electives: PSYC 120, PSYC 230, PSYC 240, PSYC 250, SOCY 225, or an additional Humanities or Fine Arts elective.
  - Students should also take a foreign language or "Global Issues" course; these include: GEOG 134, ANTH 103, ANTH 107, or POLI 160
- 2. Complete Foreign Language or Global Issues Course by:
  - a. 3 years single foreign language in high school
  - b. Native foreign speaker must pass appropriate test
  - c. Complete university level global issues course (ANTH 103, ANTH 107, GEOG 134, LITR 111)
