- 4. Must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts to satisfy SIUC's core curriculum if an AA or AS is not completed prior to transfer.
- 5. Must complete INST 101 to meet SIU Foundations of Inquiry requirement. If not taken at DACC, the student may have to take it at SIUC.
- Must complete a multi-cultural requirement. Choose from ANTH 103, ANTH 107, SOCY 200, LITR 106, MUSI 120, PHIL 104, SOCY 203, SOCY 225 or SPCH 141. If not taken at DACC, the student may have to take it at SIUC.
