Students will learn the basics of floral design. This includes the identification of plant materials and accessories as they apply to the retail florist industry.

Labs will include design practice on the most stylish arrangements that are trending in fresh and silk floral. Application projects of real flower shop work focusing in on design speed and quality as well as marketing strategies and pricing.

This is a non-credit class offered through the Community Education Department at DACC. The cost of the class is \$200 and covers instruction and supplies. Occasionally flowers are taken home for personal use, other times they are used in special projects.
