ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Step1: Must complete application packet with all supporting materials attached before the application deadline date.

Step2: A limited number of applicants will be invited to attend an orientation where they will receive additional information about completing the Registration process. Each applicant must also pass assessments with a minimum of an 8th grade reading level and 80% or higher math score.

Step3: Schedule appointment with Bushue Background Screening to do a live scan fingerprint check at a personal cost of \$30 or \$32 if paying by charge/debit card (217.342.3042). The scan will be given at DACC/ Prairie Hall- Room 106. Background checks must come back clear.

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF ALL STEPS WILL PLACE STUDENTS INTO THE FIRST AVAILABLE CLASS.

Other important information:

- 16 & 17 years old students must show proof of high school withdrawal to enroll unless student is in a College Express section.
- 100% attendance is required for State certification.
- Students must maintain an 82% grade point average or higher to move on to the Clinical portion of the CNA class. Failure to meet the minimum GPA will result in dismissal from the program.
- This program is not eligible for Federal Title IV Programs (PELL/loans) or the Illinois MAP program.
