## **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. Completion of 60 credit hours.
2. 2.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale) to be admitted to Eastern Illinois University.
3. 2.5 GPA or better to be admitted to the School of Business. (2.75 GPA for Accounting program.)
4. Completion of these five tool courses with a grade of C or better in each:

### **Eastern Illinois University Courses**

- a. BUS 2101 Financial Accounting
- b. ACC 2102 Managerial Accounting
- c. BUS2810 Business Statistics I
- d. BUS 1950 Computer Concepts
- e. MAT 2120 Finite Math

### **DACC Equivalent Courses**

- a. CACC 101
- b. CACC 105
- c. MATH 161
- d. CBUS 150
- e. MATH 135

5. Application guidelines for the College of Business:

Fall – February 15

Spring – September 15

Summer – February 15

### **Notes:**

1. It is very important that the student complete a course in Finite Math (MATH 135) and a course in Statistics (MATH 161) prior to entering EIU.
2. DACC does not offer an equivalent course to BUS2750. For admission purposes, EIU will accept CBUS 203 Business Law I. Student will take Management 2750 and 2810 after transferring to Eastern or pass proficiency exams.
3. Students taking any tool courses will not be able to take any 3000 level business classes until all tool courses are complete.
4. Students are urged to take Public Speaking instead of Oral Communication.
5. Housing at EIU is limited. Students should apply nine months to a year in advance for on-campus housing.
6. DACC recommends a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
7. Effective Fall 1992, new students or re-entering students absent more than two years and seeking an ASA degree are required to take at least one course with human relations content. See your academic advisor for a list of courses that fulfill this requirement.
8. New Students Fall 1992 should check with their advisor about EIU's Integrated Core of General Education; especially students who do not plan to complete an Associate in Science and Arts degree at DACC.
9. Students must have had two years of one high school foreign language with grades of C or better to be exempt from one year of a college foreign language.
