## Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. For Art Education Bachelor of Science & Arts (new 2010) or Bachelor in Fine Arts Option on Teacher Education:
  - a. 2.65 Grade Point Average (4.0) and maintain a 3.0 to continue in program.
  - b. Passing scores on the State of Illinois Test of Basic Skills (IBST). Please visit [www.icts.nesinc.com](http://www.icts.nesinc.com) for additional information about this test.
  - c. Completion of Speech and Hearing Clearance, contact EIU's Speech, Language, and Hearing Clinic for an appointment.
  - d. A criminal background check must be successfully completed while at EIU prior to student teaching.
  - e. Successful completion of the Technology Proficiency at EIU.
  - f. Formal Application to the Teacher Education Program.
  - g. A grade of C or better is required for all course work.
2. For Studio Art, Art History, and Graphic Design Bachelor of Fine Arts:
  - a. 2.25 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale). 2.75 for art courses.
  - b. Successful Portfolio Review (Graphic Design only).

## NOTES:

1. Required for Art Education only.
2. Art History Majors must take HIST 111 Western Civilization I and HIST 112 Western Civilization II. Art Education majors must take POLI 150 American Government and either HIST 151 U.S. History to 1865 or HIST 152 U.S. History 1865 to Present.
3. If **two** years of a **single** foreign language are completed during high school with grades of C or better, students are exempt from the foreign language requirement at the college level. **Art History majors are not exempt.** Additional elective course work **may** be needed to complete the 60 hour requirement for the degree if students are exempt from the foreign language requirement.
4. DACC does not offer four courses that are required for EIU's unique art programs:  
ART 2500 Health and Safety in the Visual Arts, ART 2910 Intro to Graphic Design,  
ART 2920 Graphic Abstractions, ART 2560 Printmaking. **In addition, EIU's unusual requirement of establishing an EIU GPA prior to taking junior-level art courses will result in three (3) years of study at EIU (5 years total college).**
5. Students pursuing 3-D Design should take ARTS 141. Student pursuing Graphic Design should take Arts 151.
