## **ADMISSION CRITERIA TO THE TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM**

*(Admission to the University does not guarantee admission into the Department of Kinesiology and Sports Studies/Teacher Education Program.)*

1. Submit a formal application for University admission to Teacher Education program.
2. a. For the Teacher Licensing, the State of Illinois will accept the ACT-Plus Writing, with a composite score of 22 and English and Writing combined score of 19; SAT score of 1030 in Critical Reading and Math and a score of 450 in Writing; or the requirement can be met by passing all parts of the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP).  
b. To become a licensed/certified teacher in the State of Illinois and individual must pass, at least, three (3) State exams:
  - Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP)
  - Assessment of Professional Teacher Skills (APT) Test
  - Content Area Test

3. A 2.65 (4.0 scale) cumulative GPA based on all work attempted at EIU and a minimum 2.65 GPA to continue in the Teacher Certification K-12 Option.

**Please note: Transfer students may use a transfer GPA for the purpose of selection if they complete items 1-3 above no later than 30 days after initial enrollment at EIU.**

## **NOTES:**

1. GSCI 105 or BIOL 137 is a requirement for this program at EIU, but does not count towards the DACC ASA degree. It is recommended that students take a life science elective AND GSCI 105 at DACC.
2. All Teacher Certification majors are required to take a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. GEOG 134, ANTH 103, POLI 160, SOCY 100 or SOCY 201 are possible options.
3. At EIU, all students must have completed a foreign language in either high school or college. This requirement may be met by completing two years of a single foreign language in high school or two semesters of a single foreign language in college.
