Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.50 GPA (4.0 scale). 2.80 GPA is required for Art Education and Art Therapy.
2. Students must apply for admission to ISU and also complete an online School of Art application. Please refer to www.cfa.ilstu.edu/art/admissions.
3. All Art Courses must be grades of C or better.
4. Successful portfolio review. Students should keep all art work to assemble their portfolio. For more information regarding the portfolio requirements, access the Illinois State website. Art History majors submit a Statement of Interest in lieu of a portfolio.

Notes:

1. Beginning Fall 2008, ISU will review a student's portfolio to determine if these classes will be equivalent to their courses: ARTS 103, 104 and 109.
2. A minimum grade of **B** is required for Art History majors in ARTS 111 and ARTS 112 (Art History I and Art History II).
3. ISU has an AMALI (cultures and traditions of Asian, the Middle East, Africa, Latin American or Indigenous Peoples of the world) course completion requirement for all graduates. LITR 104, 111; MUSI 126; PHIL 104 are offered in Humanities area.
4. Completion of Foreign Language Level III (103) is required for the B.A. French or German is highly recommended, but is **required** for Art History. All B.S. degree student must complete an additional science, math, or technology course beyond the general education requirements.
5. Art Education majors should take POLI 150 (American Government). Art History Majors should take HIST 111 (Western Civilization I).
6. Art Education majors must also take EDUC 211 (Educational Psychology), and complete the TAP/Basic Skills Test exam in reading, writing, and mathematics **at ISU prior to transferring.**
