**Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. 2.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).

**Admission Criteria to the Teacher Education Program**

**(Admission to the University does not guarantee admission to this program.)**

1. An overall GPA of at least 2.75 (4.0 scale).
2. Completion of English 101 and 102 with a grade of C or better.
3. Two letters of recommendation from college or university faculty.
4. a. To become a licensed/certified teacher in the State of Illinois and individual must pass, at least, three (3) State exams:
  - Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP)
  - Assessment of Professional Teacher Skills (APT) Test
  - Content Area Test
- b. For the Teacher Licensing, the State of Illinois will accept the ACT-Plus Writing, with a composite score of 22 and English and Writing combined score of 19; SAT score of 1030 in Critical Reading and Math and a score of 450 in Writing; or the requirement can be met by passing all parts of the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP).

1. Recommended Physical Sciences are: CHEM 100, CHEM 101, PHYS 101, or PHYS 143.
2. Recommended Life Sciences are: BIOL 100, BIOL 101, BIOL 102.
3. All teacher certification majors must complete EDUC 211 Educational Psychology.
4. Recommended courses include: ARTS 105, ARTS 115, MUSI 115, MUSI 124, MUSI 125, LITR 105, HUMN 101.
5. Recommended courses include: PHIL 101, PHIL 102, PHIL 103, LITR 122, ARTS 111, ARTS 112.
6. SIU recommends taking MUSI 120, SOCY 225, LITR 111, LITR 121, or LITR 122 to fulfill their multicultural studies requirement.
