1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).

## **Notes:**

1. Journalism majors may choose one of the following areas of specialization: News Editorial, Advertising, or Photojournalism.
2. Journalism majors must demonstrate a working knowledge of typewriting based upon a minimum rate of thirty (30) words per minute and pass a language skills exam.
3. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
4. Must complete a Human Health requirement. Choose from BIOL 136, BIOL 137, HLTH 101 or HLTH 130. If not taken here, the student may have to take it at SIUC.
5. Must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts to satisfy SIUC's core curriculum.
6. Must complete an interdisciplinary requirement. Choose from BIOL 105 or SOCY 200. If not taken here, the student may have to take it at SIUC.
7. Must complete a multi-cultural requirement. Choose from HIST 151, HIST 170, HIST 190, LITR 104, LITR 106, MUSI 120, PHIL 104, SOCY 203, SOCY 225 or SPCH 141. If not taken here, the student may have to take it at SIUC.
