## **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. **2.25** GPA (4.0 scale).

### **Notes:**

1. College of Liberal Arts students must complete one year of college foreign language regardless of high school foreign language.
2. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
3. Capstone available. SIUC offers the only ABA – approved Bachelors paralegal program in Illinois.
4. The paralegal program offers two tracks: 1) general track for those seeking a profession as a respected paralegal; 2) pre-law specialization for those seeking admission to law school.
5. Must complete an interdisciplinary requirement. Choose from BIOL 105 or SOCY 200. Must also complete a multicultural requirement. Choose from HIST 151, HIST 170, HIST 190, LITR 104, LITR 106, MUSI 120, PHIL 104, SOCY 203, SOCY 225, or SPCH 141. If not taken at DACC, student may have to take at SIU.
6. Must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts in order to satisfy SIU's core curriculum.
