Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale). Students will need a higher GPA to get accepted for any Science or Pre-Med major.

Notes:

1. Supportive Skills Requirement Elective: Students in the College of Science must take two classes (six hours) to complete the Supportive Skills requirement. Students may choose from:
 - a. Foreign Language – two college semesters of French or Spanish, or
 - b. MATH 161 Statistics and CBUS 150 Business Computer Systems.
2. New students or re-entering students absent more than two years and seeking an AS or an AA degree are required to take at least one course with human relations content. See your advisor for a list of courses that fulfill this requirement.
3. If a student does not complete an AS or AA at DACC and transfers to SIUC, the student must complete the three (3) requirements below for SIUC Core Curriculum Requirements:
 - Must Complete a Human health requirement for SIUC Core: Choose one class from: BIOL 136, BIOL137, HLTH 101 or HLTH 130. If not taken here at DACC, student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
 - Must complete a Multicultural requirement for SIUC Core: HIST 151, HIST 170, HIST 190, LITR104, LITR 106, MUSI 120, PHIL 104, SOCY 203, SOCY 225 OR SPCH 141. If not taken here at DACC, student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
 - Must complete Interdisciplinary requirement for SIUC Core: BIOL 105 or SOCY 200. This is not built into the DACC guide because there are so many elective hours already; however, if it is not taken here at DACC, student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
4. The Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Zoology at SIUC is offered with the following specializations:
 - Animal Biology
 - Environmental Biology
 - Fisheries Biology and Aquatic Conservation
 - Pre-Veterinary Science
 - Wildlife Biology and Conservation

The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Zoology is for students who plan on non-science careers but desire a strong background in zoology. The major includes 22-23 hours of free electives which can be used for a minor or second major.
