**ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

*(Admission to the College of Education does not guarantee admission to the teacher education program.)*

A student is eligible to make an application to the Teacher Education Program with:

1. An overall GPA of 2.75 or higher.
2. Completion of ENGL 101 and 102 with a grade of C or better.
3.
  - a. For the Teacher Licensing, the State of Illinois will accept the ACT-Plus Writing, with a composite score of 22 and English and Writing combined score of 19; SAT score of 1030 in Critical Reading and Math and a score of 450 in Writing; or the requirement can be met by passing all parts of the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP).
  - b. To become a licensed/certified teacher in the State of Illinois and individual must pass, at least, three (3) State exams:
    - Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP)
    - Assessment of Professional Teacher Skills (APT) Test
    - Content Area Test
