Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. The minimum GPA for application to all programs in the Department of ACE is 2.75. Meeting the minimum may not ensure your admission, since the actual GPA of the yearly applicant pool determines the GPA required.
2. Sixty (60) semester hours of transfer credit.

Notes:

1. Each Ag major is slightly different. Check with your counselor for correct classes.
2. See your DACC advisor for General Education Requirements list and choices for non-Western culture classes that meet the human relations content.
3. For all programs in the College of ACES, transfer applicants must have completed, at minimum, two years of one language other than English in high school or at least one semester of a language other than English at the college level. To graduate from U of I, you will need 3 years in high school of the same foreign language or 3 semesters of college of the same Foreign Language to Graduate from the College of ACES.
4. If you have completed the Foreign Language Requirements in high school, you need to take some elective hours to have enough credits to graduate from DACC with your ASA. You must earn 60 credit hours and meet all the requirements to earn an ASA from DACC.
5. If needing to choose an elective, MATH 161 Statistics is recommended by the U of I.
