Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.8 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).
2. Sixty (60) hours of credit.
3. The Online Application is strongly encouraged. Your application will be processed more quickly and you will be able to check its status online. Online Applications can be accessed at www.ar.uiuc.edu/prospective/ugrad/apply.html.
4. a. For the Teacher Licensing, the State of Illinois will accept the ACT-Plus Writing, with a composite score of 22 and English and Writing combined score of 19; SAT score of 1030 in Critical Reading and Math and a score of 450 in Writing; or the requirement can be met by passing all parts of the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP).
b. To become a licensed/certified teacher in the State of Illinois and individual must pass, at least, three (3) State exams:
 - Test of Academic Proficiency
 - Assessment of Professional Teacher Skills (APT) Test
 - Content Area Test

5. Strong science background is encouraged.

NOTES:

1. Physical Education activity courses (maximum six (6) hours) should include one from each of the following categories: Fitness, dance, gymnastics, swimming, field activities, and racquet activities and may be taken at four-year institution.
2. Physical Education majors may choose from the following areas of concentration: Bioscience, Curriculum and Instruction, Social Science of Sport, or Personalized area of concentration.
3. All teacher certification majors are required to take a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. Recommended course is LITR 111 Non-Western Literature.
4. Transfer students must have completed third year level of high school or third semester of college of a single foreign language. If foreign language has been completed, students may choose an elective course, including either CBUS 150 or INFO 135. Other recommendations: ANTH 107, LITR 111, PEMW 150, HLTH 130.
5. Elective courses include: HLTH 101, EDUC 101, PEMW 150, PSYC 120, or PEMW course. Please see your advisor for a complete list.
