## **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale).

### **Notes:**

1. Not more than 16 hours of 100-level Psychology courses, or Psychology courses transferred from community colleges, may count toward the Major in Psychology.
2. Grades of C or better required for admission to the major. Upon transferring to ISU, a total of seven (7) additional hours of psychology classes are required.
3. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. It is required for teacher certification majors.
4. ISU requires the third level of a college foreign language for a BA in Psychology. Students who want ISU's B.S. degree in Psychology can fulfill the foreign language requirement with three years of one foreign language in high school or completion of the second semester or higher of college-level foreign language with grades of C or better or equivalent proficiency as determined by exam. Recommended courses if requirement has been met are ANTH 107, GEOG 134, POLI 160, PSYC 120, PSYC 230, PSYC 205, PSYC 260, or SOCY 100.
5. Students can meet ISU's Global Studies graduation requirement by completing POLI 160, GEOG 134, or ANTH 107 as a DACC social science requirement. If a different social science elective is completed, the Global Studies requirement must be met at ISU. There are dozens of courses to choose from in this area once the student is enrolled at ISU.
6. Students who major in Psychology must complete two laboratory courses. Biology 100 or BIOL 101 is preferred for Life Science. Physical Science preference is CHEM 100, CHEM 101, or PHYS 101. Additional required PSYC research methods courses will be taken at ISU.
