**Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. Minimum 2.6 GPA (4.0 scale) is required for transfer admission.
2. Minimum 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale) is recommended for transfer admission.
3. Must complete a minimum of 26 hours of transfer credit.

## Notes:

1. The Bachelor of Science degree satisfies the education requirements for licensure in the State of Illinois as overseen by the Department of Professional Regulation. Graduates who have acquired five years of architectural experience/training through the Intern Development Program (IDP) qualify to take the Architect Registration Examination (A.R.E.) in Illinois. Students who have completed 90 hours of the degree are eligible to participate in the Intern Development Program (IDP).
2. Three years minimum of Architectural Studies courses at SIU are required to finish the Bachelor of Science degree. Beginning fall 2007, SIUC is offering a three-year fast track program that begins summer semester. Students will apply for fall entry and then be sent a separate application for this program. Twenty students are accepted into this program. Verify with your counselor if this is your intent.
3. Students must take both MATH 111 and MATH 114 or test into Math 120 to enter this class. MATH 111 should be taken during the first summer, and MATH 114 should be taken in the fall.
4. Three-year plan for transfer students: Core Curriculum course requirements must also be met per university and program requirements. Even though this plan begins with a summer semester, the initial application to SIUC must indicate you are applying for admission into the Architectural Studies program for the fall semester. After you have been admitted to SIUC, you will receive a separate program application. The program application will allow you to indicate your interest in the three-year plan beginning with the summer semester. Enrollment in this option is limited to the first 20 qualified applicants.
5. Must place into MATH 125 with approved and documented math placement test scores or by completing MATH 111 with a C or better. Both MATH 111 and MATH 114 are required for the Architectural Studies program.
6. Recommended Fine Arts electives are: ARTS 115, ARTS 105, LITR 105, or MUSI 115.
7. Recommended Humanities electives: LITR 114, PHIL 101, PHIL 102, or PHIL 103.
8. In order to meet both the social science requirement and the SIUC multicultural requirement, ANTH 103 or ANTH 107 is recommended.
