Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).
2. Students should keep a portfolio of their work in all studio art classes.

Notes:

1. DACC recommends a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. A Third World or Non-Western Culture course is required for teacher certification. See your counselor for a list of these courses.
2. Art Education majors must take PSYC 100. All other majors can take any social science (IAI) elective.
3. The Foreign Language requirement is for all students pursuing the BA degree, regardless of high school foreign language completed. Art History students are recommended to take French or German. Students pursuing a BFA may substitute an elective.
4. Due to additional courses for art majors, a bachelor's degree will generally take 3 years to complete after transferring to SIU (5 total years).
5. Art Education, Ceramics, Communication Design, Industrial Design, and Metalsmithing students are recommended to take ARTS 115.
6. The School of Art and Design offers two undergraduate degrees, the Bachelor of Fine Arts and the Bachelor of Arts. The BFA, a professional degree, includes ten specializations: Art Education, Ceramics, Communication Design, Drawing, Glass, Industrial Design, Metalsmithing, Painting, Printmaking, and Sculpture. Under the BA degree there are two majors: Art and Design. The BA degree in Art includes three specializations: Art Education, Art History, and General Studio.
