## **Admission Criteria for the School of Social Work**

*(Admission to the University does not guarantee admission into this program.)*

1. Transfer students must have an overall GPA of 2.25 (4.0 scale). Students may transfer at any time, but there are advantages to completing a baccalaureate-oriented associates degree program (AA or AS).

## **Notes:**

1. The B.S. degree program in social work meets the objectives of students with career interests in the human services field. Positions in child welfare, gerontology, mental health, health services, women's programs, and public and private social service agencies are typically available to graduates.
2. SIU requires students to choose between CHEM 100, PHYS 101, or PHYS 143.
3. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. Choose from HIST 141, HIST 142, LITR 111, LITR 121, LITR 122, or PHIL 104.
4. Choose from ARTS 111, ARTS 112, MUSI 115, HUMN 101, ARTS 105, LITR 105, PHIL 101, PHIL 102, or PHIL 1-3.
