Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 3.25 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale)
2. ENGL 101, ENGL 102, MATH 161, SOCY 100, PSYC 100, CECN 102, and CECN 103 are required for admission to this program.
3. Second level of foreign language at the high school or college level are required for admission. Third level of foreign language is required for graduation. If this requirement was met in high school, additional electives may be needed to meet the AA 60 credit hour requirement.

Notes:

1. Accreditation by the American Council on Education for Journalism and Mass Communication.
2. DACC recommends a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
3. Starting in 2018, UIUC requires students to complete one course in Non-Western Cultures (NW), one course in U.S. Minority Cultures (US), and one course in Western/Comparative Cultures (WCC). Courses that can be taken at DACC to meet these requirements are SOCY 225, POLI 240, ANTH 103, HIST 122, LITR 111, HIST 111, HIST 112, HIST 151, HIST 152, LITR 121, and LITR 122.
