**Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. Competition for these majors usually requires a 3.0 GPA or higher (4.0 scale).
2. Students should apply for a **Fall** Semester transfer due to course sequencing.
3. Admission is subject to a successful portfolio review by the University of Illinois. Students are encouraged to apply early in the filing period to allow time for the portfolio review. Detailed information regarding the portfolio can be found at:

4. Art History majors may also submit a writing sample of 750-1500 words on a related topic.
5. Art Education also requires successful completion of the Illinois Certification Test of Basic Skills or meeting requirements through ACT or SAT. **Information on registering for this test is available at [www.icts.nesinc.com](http://www.icts.nesinc.com).** You should register for a fall test date and ask that the score be reported to the University of Illinois at Urbana/Champaign.
6. Art Education majors must pass a criminal background check and blood borne pathogens training to continue in the certification track. These must be completed by the end of the first semester at the University of Illinois.

**Notes:**

1. Two (2) years of a foreign language in high school or two (2) semesters in college, the math elective, and ARTS 117, 118, 130 and 151, and ENGL 101 and ENGL 102 must be successfully completed before transferring to the University of Illinois.
2. Completion of **4 years of a foreign language in high school** or **four (4) levels of the same foreign language in college** is required for Art History. Three years in high school or three (3) semesters in college is required for all other art majors. French or German is recommended.
3. Required for Art Education only.
4. Recommended for Art History majors. See a DACC counselor/academic advisor for a list of **transferable University of Illinois General Education courses**.
5. Recommended for Art History Majors.
6. Recommended for Painting majors. This course is only offered in the Fall semester at DACC. If taking this course, take the math elective in the spring semester.
7. Recommended for Graphic Design majors.
