Transfer Admission Requirements

Highest admission priority will be granted to transfer students with the strongest academic records.

ISU's preferred filing period for fall transfer students is September 1 – January 15. For spring semester, the preferred filing period is April 1 – August 1. ISU encourages students to apply early.

Admission Criteria to the Department of Communication Science and Disorders *(Admission to the University does not guarantee admission to the Department of Communication Science and Disorders.)*

1. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3 (4.0 scale). Middle % GPA 3.44 - 3.84

Notes:

1. Students can meet ISU's Global Studies graduation requirement by completing POLI 160, GEOG 134, or ANTH 107 as a DACC social science requirement. If a different social science elective is completed, the Global Studies requirement must be met at ISU. There are dozens of courses to choose from in this area once the student is enrolled at ISU.
2. All graduates of the College of Arts and Sciences must satisfy a foreign language requirement that may be met by: 3 years of one foreign language in high school or completion of the second semester or higher of college-level foreign language with a grade of C or better. If you have completed this requirement, it is recommended to take MATH 111 if needed, HLTH 101, or HLTH 130.
3. MATH 135 and MATH 161 are required for ISU. One or both courses may be taken at DACC.
