Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).

Notes:

1. Communication Studies majors may specialize in one of the following areas: Persuasive Communication, Performance Studies, Public Relations, Organizational Communication, Interpersonal Communication, or Intercultural Communication.
2. SIU's College of LAS requires foreign language at the second semester college level. This is equivalent to two years of one foreign language in high school, but SIU requires that a proficiency test be passed if two semesters are not completed at the college level.
3. Electives should be in the areas of drama, music, film, psychology, sociology, and literature. Students specializing in Intercultural Communication are recommended to take PSYC 100, SOCY 100, PSCY 240, and SOCY 225.
4. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
5. If transferring without an Associates degree, student must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts to satisfy SIU's core curriculum.
6. Elective may be needed to reach 60 hour requirement.
