Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.00 GPA (4.00 scale) for general admission.

Notes:

1. Junior standing in the School of Business means that the student has:
 - a. Completed a minimum of 60 credit hours with a 2.25 or higher GPA.
 - b. Admission to the School of Business is conditional until the completion of 15 hours of approved course work at ISU with a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or higher (5.0 scale).
2. Effective Fall 1992, new students or re-entering students absent more than two years and seeking an A.S.A. degree are required to take at least one course with human relations content. See your counselor for list of courses that fulfill this requirement.
3. Foreign language graduation requirement is two years of the same language in high school, or two semesters of the same language in college with grades of C or better.
4. The School of Business has an upper division online degree completion program available. Because of ISU's tuition and fee schedule, online courses will actually cost a total of \$500 less per semester than physically going to Terre Haute to take the classes.
