### **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale). You may need a higher GPA to get selected for any Forestry Major. Forestry concentrations include: Forest Hydrology, Forest Resources Management, Forest Recreation and Park Management, Urban Forest Management, and Wildlife Habitat Management and Conservation.

### **Notes:**

1. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. Students interested in Urban Forest Management should take POLI 231 State and Local Government as a social science elective.
2. If AGRI 102 is taken, an additional social science IAI elective will be needed.
3. Health elective choices are HLTH 101 or HLTH 130.
4. If a student **does not complete** an AA or AS at DACC and transfers to SIU, the student must complete the three (3) requirements below for SIUC Core Curriculum Requirements:
  - Must Complete a Human health requirement for SIU Core: Choose 1 class from: BIOL 136, BIOL137, HLTH 101 or HLTH 130. If not taken here at DACC, student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
  - Must complete a Multicultural requirement for SIU Core: ANTH 103, ANTH 107, SOCY 200, LITR 106, MUSI 120, PHIL 104, SOCY 203, SOCY 225 or SPCH 141. If not taken here at DACC, student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
  - Must complete INST 101 to meet the SIU Foundations of Inquiry requirement. If not taken here at DACC, the student will have to complete this requirement at SIUC.
5. DACC Ag classes are offered on a two-year rotation. Students need to be sure they enroll in these classes when possible, since they are only offered once every two years. AGRI 102 FALL odd, AGRI 180 FALL even.
