MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING of July 19, 2018

On July 19, 2018, the Board of Trustees of Community College District 507, in the Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign, and Ford in the State of Illinois, met in regular session in the Board Room, Vermilion Hall, Room 302 at Danville Area Community College, Danville, Illinois.

ITEM 1: CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dave Harby called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

ITEM 2: PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Ms. Addison Wise, Student Trustee, led the Board and those in attendance in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

ITEM 3: ROLL CALL

The roll was called. Trustees present: Bill Black, Dave Harby, Terry Hill, Tonya Hill, Dr. Ron Serfoss, and Student Trustee Addison Wise. Trustees absent: John Spezia and Greg Wolfe.

Others present: President Dr. Stephen Nacco, Board Secretary Kerri Thurman, Dave Kietzmann, Jill Cranmore, Tammy Clark-Betancourt, Mike Cunningham, Lara Conklin, Jerry Davis, Dr. Penny McConnell, Phillip Langley, Matt Metcalf, and Dan Grelecki.

Media present: None.

ITEM 4: ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mr. Harby asked if there were any changes requested to the agenda. With no changes requested, upon motion by Dr. Serfoss, and a second by Mr. Hill, the agenda was approved as presented. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

ITEM 5: RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Dr. Nacco introduced the following members of the Administrative Council: Dave Kietzmann, Executive Vice President, Instruction and Student Services; Jill Cranmore, Vice President, Human Resources; Tammy Clark-Betancourt, Vice President, Finance/Chief Financial Officer; Mike Cunningham, Vice President, Administrative Services; and Lara Conklin, Executive Director, College Relations. Also present: Jerry Davis, Davis and Delanois; Dr. Penny McConnell, Dean, Liberal Arts and Library Services; Phillip Langley, Instructor, Developmental Education; Matt Metcalf, Ci Living, WCIA; and Dan Grelecki, Old National Insurance.

Media present: None.

ITEM 6: LIBERAL ARTS & LIBRARY SERVICES REPORT

Dr. Penny McConnell introduced Phillip Langley and Matt Metcalf who co-taught an Intro to Television Production class this past spring. Mr. Langley and Mr. Metcalf shared an overview of the course and how they introduced broadcast production and how media has changed in broadcasting into the class. A video interview of student Jacob Lashuay was

shown to the group. Mr. Lashuay graduated in May and is currently completing an internship at WCIA Channel 3.

Mr. Langley and Mr. Metcalf also shared their vision for the future in class offerings and possible certificates and/or degrees.

The Board and Dr. Nacco thanked Mr. Langley and Mr. Metcalf for their report and for their commitment to students reaching their goals.

ITEM 12: NEW BUSINESS

A. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF AUTHORIZATION TO PERMIT INTERFUND LOANS AS NEEDED FOR THE PERIOD OF AUGUST 2018 THROUGH JULY 2019

Due to the timing of revenue and expenditure amounts that occur during the year, several of the College's Funds experience a negative cash balance at various times during the year. In addition, most of our grants are on a reimbursable basis. We incur the cost and then periodically, based on the grant regulations, request reimbursement for these expenditures, which has a negative effect on cash flow.

Interfund loans do not change the College's total cash balance, but the transaction does provide for each individual Fund to reflect a positive cash balance. This request will

provide lending options through the FY19 fiscal year and address the anticipated negative cash balance during the next year. The current authorization for interfund loans ends on July 31, 2018.

Upon motion by Dr. Serfoss, and a second by Mrs. Hill, the Board approved the authorization to permit interfund loans as needed for the period of August 2018 through July 2019. The motion passed by roll call vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

B. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF A CONTRACT FOR GROUP LIFE AND DISABILITY BENEFITS

The Insurance Committee has completed the second phase of the insurance benefit review project with ONI Risk Partners (ONI). This phase analyzed the employee benefits for basic life insurance, optional life insurance, spousal life insurance, dependent life insurance, accidental death and dismemberment insurance (AD&D), short-term disability and long-term disability. ONI determined that all of our current plans are outdated as these plans were created in 1983. The plans offer underinsured policies as compared to national benchmarks.

ONI has consulted with the Insurance Committee. The Insurance Committee is comprised of 15 members: 5 administrators, 5 classified staff, 4 faculty, and 1 confidential staff. The Insurance Committee recommends following the consultant's suggestion to update all plans listed above by partnering with Principal Life Insurance Company. The proposed new plans offer greater employee benefits. A recommendation is requested to offer all full-time employees basic life insurance of \$20,000. All other benefits will be on a voluntary, guarantee issue basis. This new plan will include an Employee Assistance Program (EAP), which will allow us to terminate our existing EAP plan.

Upon motion by Mr. Black, and a second by Mr. Hill, the Board approved the recommendation to contract with Principal Life Insurance Company for group life and disability benefits. The motion passed by roll call vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

C. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF RETIREMENT

Nursing Instructor Dianne Manganaro submitted her letter of intent to retire effective June 30, 2018 after 13 years of service.

Upon motion by Mrs. Hill, and a second by Dr. Serfoss, the Board approved the retirement of Nursing Instructor Dianne Manganaro effective June 30, 2018. The motion passed by roll call vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

Tractor/Trailer Training Specialist Lois Woodward submitted her letter of intent to retire effective July 31, 2018 after 4 years of service.

Upon motion by Mr. Hill, and a second by Mrs. Hill, the Board approved the retirement of Tractor/Trailer Training Specialist Lois Woodward effective June 30, 2018. The motion passed by roll call vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

D. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF RENEWAL OF LEASE FOR THE AMERICAN JOB CENTER

The proposed lease is effective 7/1/18 through 6/30/22 in the amount of \$72,000 annually. The College is responsible for the lease amount, but the community partner agencies cover all American Job Center operating costs.

Upon motion by Dr. Serfoss, and a second by Mr. Hill, the Board approved the renewal of the lease with Vermilion Development for the American Job Center. The motion passed by roll call vote: 6 yeas, 0 nays.

- I. WITNESSETH, that in consideration of an annual base salary for **Fiscal Year (2018-2019)** of \$98,000.00 less any legal authorized deductions, including but not limit to required SURS deduction paid by the employee, said Employee agrees to well and faithfully perform the duties of **Executive Director of College Foundation and Grant Development** and such other duties connected with Community College District No. 507 as may be assigned by the Danville Area Community College Board or its duly authorized representative. For each full month of employment such salary will be paid in semi-monthly installments on the pay period dates as established and published by the Payroll Department. For each partial month of employment, payment will be prorated. It is understood that as an administrative employee, you will serve at the pleasure of the Danville Area Community College Board of Trustees.
- II. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
 - A. That this term shall commence on the 10th day of September, 2018, and terminate on the 30th day of June 2019, and shall include all the service days designated on the official College calendar as it now appears or may hereafter be amended, that occur on or within these two dates.
 - B. That there shall be deducted from the salary of said Employee an amount equal to the pay for one day of service for each day of service during the employment agreement term in which it is not performed, unless absence from duty with pay is specifically authorized by Board Policy, or unless absence from duty is occasioned by illness or injury qualifying as sick leave within the provisions of the Board's established sick leave policy.
 - C. That if said Employee resigns, is lawfully discharged, or is released before the completion of said term, final settlement shall be made so the total amount which the Employee shall have received shall be an amount equal to the product of the number of days of service multiplied by the amount considered as pay for one day of service. Days of service actually performed shall be deemed to include sick leave days and authorized absence days for which pay has been authorized prior to the date of release, discharge, or termination.
 - D. That by acceptance of this Contract the Employee hereby agrees to be governed by the policies of the Danville Area Community College Board to perform the duties as assigned by authorized College Administrators.

Specially Funded Contract For Administrative and Professional Staff

With

Community College District No. 507 Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign, and Ford Counties, Illinois 2000 East Main Street Danville, IL 61832

This Contract is made and entered into, by and between **David Harris** (hereinafter referred to as the "Employee") and the Board of Trustees, Danville Area Community College, No. 507 (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"). The Board and the Employee hereby voluntarily agree as follows:

- I. That in consideration of a semi-monthly salary in the gross amount of \$2,187.50 Dollars less any legal authorized deductions, including but not limited to required SURS deduction paid by the employee during the term of this Contract, the Employee agrees: 1) to well and faithfully perform the duties of **Director**, **Danville Correctional Center Educational Program** or the duties of such other specially funded position of employment which the Board or its duly authorized representative may assign the Employee to perform during the term of this Agreement; and 2) to the remaining terms of this Contract.
- II. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
 - A. That the source of funds for payment of Employee's salary and benefits under this Contract are funds made available to the Board by **Department of Corrections** for the **Danville Correctional Center Educational Program** project, hereinafter referred to as "special funds".
 - B. That this Contract, and every part hereof, is conditional upon and strictly limited by the availability of special funds for such salaries made available to the Board by **Department of Corrections** for the aforementioned project and shall remain executory and without effect until said funds are actually contracted.
 - C. This Contract and the employment relationship between the Board and the Employee shall commence on the 2nd day of August 2018, and terminate not later than the 30th day of June 2019. This Contract and the employment relationship between the Employee and the Board may be terminated prior to June 30, 2019, when, in the Board's judgement, special funds allocated to administrative and professional salaries for this program become inadequate or unavailable to finance the Employee's position of employment. The Board may also terminate this Contract and the employment relationship for other legitimate reasons or circumstances, as stated elsewhere in this Contract. The Employee's work days shall include all the service and in-service days designated on the official College calendar, as it now appears or may hereafter be amended by the Board, that occur during the term of this Contract.

- D. That there shall be deducted from the salary of Employee, an amount equal to the pay for one day of service for each day of service during the contract term on which the employee is absent from duty, unless absence from duty with pay is specifically authorized by the Board, or unless absence from duty is occasioned by illness or injury qualifying as paid sick leave within the provisions of the Board's established sick leave policy, as the same may be amended from time to time by the Board.
- E. Pay Frequency. During the term of this Contract, the Salary specified in Part I, above, will be paid semi-monthly on the pay period dates as established and published by the College Payroll Department. If the Employee works less than a complete payroll cycle, then the Employee's salary for such period shall be reduced pro rata.
- III. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
- A. The Employee's position of employment under this Contract is depending on the employee's compliance with all Department of Corrections Directives and the Department of Corrections approval to work within the facility.
- B. That Community College District 507 has entered into said specially funded project, within which this position of employment is offered, as a special service to the surrounding community it serves. It is understood that as an administrative employee, you will serve at the pleasure of the Danville Area Community College Board of Trustees.
- C. That the specially funded project within which this position of employment is offered is a special project to the Community College District 507 and although this project may be ancillary and supportive of the college curriculum, it is not part of the normal operations of Community College District 507.
- D. That Employee's position of employment under this Contract is dependent upon the continued availability of special funds for this program for its continued existence. Because this is a specially funded position of employment, it is understood and agreed that the Employee is not eligible for tenure under the Illinois Community College Tenure Act, 110 ILCS 805/3B-1, et seq.
- E. The parties acknowledge that the factors and timing which determine whether or not special funding for the Employee's position will be granted or are adequate for the contract period or will be available for possible renewal or extension at the termination of any contract period are totally controlled by the special funding source.
- F. That absent adequate special funding which has been allocated to administrative and professional salaries for this project, there is no assurance that this position of employment will be continued for this contract period.
- G. Upon termination of this Contract for any reason, including but not limited to its expiration on **June 30, 2019**, there is no assurance that continued employment will be available or offered to the Employee by the Board.

- H. That any Board policies or procedures concerning the termination, renewal or reduction in force of employment contracts for positions covered by Board Policy are hereby mutually waived, and it is agreed that the provisions of said policies or procedures shall not govern the termination or renewal of the employment relationship created by this Contract.
- I. This Contract supersedes any contrary Board policies or procedures, except as otherwise expressly stated herein. The Board Policy concerning Probation (Board Policy 4043) and the Board Policy concerning Disciplinary Suspension or Dismissal for Cause (Board Policy 4055) shall, however, be applicable during the term of this Contract. The application of Board Policy 4055 shall not, however, be construed as a limitation on the Board's right to terminate this Contract and the employment relationship at any time, should the Board determine that special funds for this program have become inadequate or unavailable to finance the Employee's continued employment.
- J. That due to the contractual relationship between the Board and the special funding source, there is no guarantee that such special funds, either in part or whole, will be renewed or continued from year to year, and therefore, it is mutually agreed that this agreement shall not be automatically renewable from contract term to contract term. This agreement and the employment relationship between the Employee and the Board shall automatically terminate not later than **June 30, 2019.**
- K. That because of the uncertainty of the special funding source and the limitations of this totally specially funded budget, the parties agree that the Board may terminate this Contract, and the employment relationship, during its term by providing the Employee with fourteen (14) days notice of termination. Such notice shall be based upon the Board's determination that: 1) there are, in the Board's judgment, insufficient special funds allocated to administrative and professional salaries to support this Employee's continued employment; or 2) Community College District 507 will not participate or will not continue to participate in all or part of this specially funded project. The reason for termination and date of termination of this Contract will be specified in said notice. For purposes of this Section, "notice" means a written notice delivered in person or deposited in the U. S. Mail by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the Employee's last known address. Compensation provided under this contract shall immediately cease upon the termination date specified in any such termination notice. The decision of the Board shall be final.
- L. This contract will remain in force and effect for the duration of the contract term except as conditioned above.
- M. This Agreement constitutes the complete and entire Agreement between the Employee and the Board, and supersedes any prior agreements or practices. No other promises or agreements, either express or implied, shall be binding unless hereinafter reduced to writing, signed by both the Employee and the Board, and supported by adequate consideration.
- N. This contract will be considered as null and void if the employee fails to past the security clearance or meet Department of Corrections' standards in the background investigation.

Specially Funded Contract For Administrative and Professional Staff

This Contract is made and entered into, by and between **Brittany Woodworth** (hereinafter referred to as the "Employee") and the Board of Trustees, Danville Area Community College, No. 507 (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"). The Board and the Employee hereby voluntarily agree as follows:

- I. That in consideration of a semi-monthly salary in the gross amount of \$1,458.33 Dollars less any legal authorized deductions, including but not limited to required SURS deduction paid by the employee during the term of this Contract, the Employee agrees: 1) to well and faithfully perform the duties of Business Service Representative- VCW or the duties of such other specially funded position of employment which the Board or its duly authorized representative may assign the Employee to perform during the term of this Agreement; and 2) to the remaining terms of this Contract.
- II. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
 - A. That the source of funds for payment of Employee's salary and benefits under this Contract are funds made available to the Board by **Vermilion County Works Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act** for the **Department of Labor** project, hereinafter referred to as "special funds".
 - B. That this Contract, and every part hereof, is conditional upon and strictly limited by the availability of special funds for such salaries made available to the Board by **Illinois Department of Commerce Economic Opportunity** for the aforementioned project and shall remain executory and without effect until said funds are actually contracted.
 - C. This Contract and the employment relationship between the Board and the Employee shall commence on the 4th day of September 2018, and terminate not later than the 30th day of June 2019. This Contract and the employment relationship between the Employee and the Board may be terminated prior to June 30, 2019, when, in the Board's judgement, special funds allocated to administrative and professional salaries for this program become inadequate or unavailable to finance the Employee's position of employment. The Board may also terminate this Contract and the employment relationship for other legitimate reasons or circumstances, as stated elsewhere in this Contract. The Employee's work days shall include all the service and in-service days designated on the official College calendar, as it now appears or may hereafter be amended by the Board, that occur during the term of this Contract.

- D. That there shall be deducted from the salary of Employee, an amount equal to the pay for one day of service for each day of service during the contract term on which the employee is absent from duty, unless absence from duty with pay is specifically authorized by the Board, or unless absence from duty is occasioned by illness or injury qualifying as paid sick leave within the provisions of the Board's established sick leave policy, as the same may be amended from time to time by the Board.
- E. Pay Frequency. During the term of this Contract, the Salary specified in Part I, above, will be paid semi-monthly on the pay period dates as established and published by the College Payroll Department. If the Employee works less than a complete payroll cycle, then the Employee's salary for such period shall be reduced pro rata.
- III. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
 - A. That Community College District 507 has entered into said specially funded project, within which this position of employment is offered, as a special service to the surrounding community it serves. It is understood that as an administrative employee, you will serve at the pleasure of the Danville Area Community College Board of Trustees.
 - B. That the specially funded project within which this position of employment is offered is a special project to the Community College District 507 and although this project may be ancillary and supportive of the college curriculum, it is not part of the normal operations of Community College District 507.
 - C. That Employee's position of employment under this Contract is dependent upon the continued availability of special funds for this program for its continued existence. Because this is a specially funded position of employment, it is understood and agreed that the Employee is not eligible for tenure under the Illinois Community College Tenure Act, 110 ILCS 805/3B-1, et seq.
 - D. The parties acknowledge that the factors and timing which determine whether or not special funding for the Employee's position will be granted or are adequate for the contract period or will be available for possible renewal or extension at the termination of any contract period are totally controlled by the special funding source.
 - E. That absent adequate special funding which has been allocated to administrative and professional salaries for this project, there is no assurance that this position of employment will be continued for this contract period.
 - F. Upon termination of this Contract for any reason, including but not limited to its expiration on **June 30, 2019**, there is no assurance that continued employment will be available or offered to the Employee by the Board.

- G. That any Board policies or procedures concerning the termination, renewal or reduction in force of employment contracts for positions covered by Board Policy are hereby mutually waived, and it is agreed that the provisions of said policies or procedures shall not govern the termination or renewal of the employment relationship created by this Contract.
- H. This Contract supersedes any contrary Board policies or procedures, except as otherwise expressly stated herein. The Board Policy concerning Probation (Board Policy 4043) and the Board Policy concerning Disciplinary Suspension or Dismissal for Cause (Board Policy 4055) shall, however, be applicable during the term of this Contract. The application of Board Policy 4055 shall not, however, be construed as a limitation on the Board's right to terminate this Contract and the employment relationship at any time, should the Board determine that special funds for this program have become inadequate or unavailable to finance the Employee's continued employment.
- I. That due to the contractual relationship between the Board and the special funding source, there is no guarantee that such special funds, either in part or whole, will be renewed or continued from year to year, and therefore, it is mutually agreed that this agreement shall not be automatically renewable from contract term to contract term. This agreement and the employment relationship between the Employee and the Board shall automatically terminate not later than **June 30, 2019.**
- J. That because of the uncertainty of the special funding source and the limitations of this totally specially funded budget, the parties agree that the Board may terminate this Contract, and the employment relationship, during its term by providing the Employee with fourteen (14) days notice of termination. Such notice shall be based upon the Board's determination that: 1) there are, in the Board's judgment, insufficient special funds allocated to administrative and professional salaries to support this Employee's continued employment; or 2) Community College District 507 will not participate or will not continue to participate in all or part of this specially funded project. The reason for termination and date of termination of this Contract will be specified in said notice. For purposes of this Section, "notice" means a written notice delivered in person or deposited in the U. S. Mail by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the Employee's last known address. Compensation provided under this contract shall immediately cease upon the termination date specified in any such termination notice. The decision of the Board shall be final.
- K. This contract will remain in force and effect for the duration of the contract term except as conditioned above.
- L. This Agreement constitutes the complete and entire Agreement between the Employee and the Board, and supersedes any prior agreements or practices. No other promises or agreements, either express or implied, shall be binding unless hereinafter reduced to writing, signed by both the Employee and the Board, and supported by adequate consideration.

IV.	It is hereby further mutually agreed that this contract shall be without force and effect unless it is in possession of the Board, bearing the signature of the Employee and the Secretary of the Board on or before the 31st day of August 2018.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: The renewal of the lease with Vermilion Development for the American Job

Center was included on the July 19, 2018 Board agenda. As clarification, the amount of the lease is \$72,000 ANNUALLY and is effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2022. The square footage of the leased space located at 407 North Franklin Street is 5,614 square feet. The College is responsible for the lease amount, but the community partner agencies cover all American Job

Center operating costs.

SECOND ADDENDUM TO LEASE

Between

VERMILION DEVELOPMENT, LLC and DANVILLE AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

At 407 N. Franklin St. Danville, IL

Whereas, Danville Area Community College (Lessee) and Vermilion Development, LLC (Lessor) entered into a First Addendum to Lease on May 1, 2016.

Whereas the Lease is currently in full force and effect, and;

Whereas, Lessee desires to extend the lease for said property from Lessor, subject to the terms of said Lease;

Now therefore the undersigned do hereby agree as follows:

The terms of the Lease are amended (And shall now be referred to as the Second Amended Term) as set forth below:

- 1. As of July 1, 2018 (Second Amended Lease Addendum Date), the Premises shall be leased, the three office spaces (1,060 square feet) in the 407C office space, shown on Schedule 1A, and the adjoining original Demised Premises (4,554square feet), shown on Schedule 1, for a total of 5,614 square feet.
- 2. Section 1(DEMISED PREMISES) is amended as follows: Lessor owns land and improvements (the "Property") located at 407 N. Franklin, Danville, Illinois, more particularly identified on Schedule 1 & 1A attached hereto and incorporated herein (the "Building" and the "Demised Premises" in the "Building"). The Lessor leases to Lessee and the Lessee leases from Lessor approximately 5,614 square feet of the Building for its exclusive use and an additional 1,650 square feet of shared space, (hereafter the "Demised Premises").
- 3. Section 4 (**RENT**) is amended to read as follows:

 During the Second Amended Term, Lessee shall pay annual rent for the Demised Premises in the amount of \$72,000.00, payable in the consecutive monthly

installments of \$6,000.00, the first payment of which shall be due and payable on the Second Amended Lease Addendum Date.

The Second Addendum shall be effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2022. In the event of any conflict between the Lease and this Addendum, the terms of this Addendum shall control. All provisions of the Lease, not amended hereby, shall remain as written and the parties agree to be bound by the terms of such Lease as amended hereby.

The parties executing this Second Addendum on behalf of Danville Area Community College and the Vermilion Development, LLC represent and warrant that they are duly authorized on behalf their respective businesses to execute this Addendum, that any and all action necessary for such authority has been taken and done; by their signatures they bind their respective businesses to this Addendum and they reaffirm the Lease.

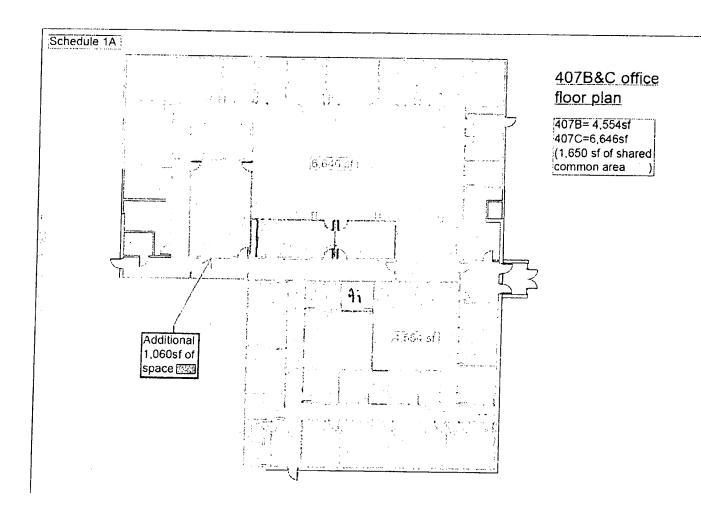

RESOLUTION FOR THE PERMANENT TRANSFER OF EARNED INTEREST MONIES FROM THE WORKING CASH FUND TO THE EDUCATION FUND

WHEREAS, Community College District No. 507, Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign and Ford, State of Illinois, has heretofore duly established a Working Cash Fund, pursuant to the Illinois Public Community College Act; and,

WHEREAS, interest earned on Working Cash Fund monies may be permanently transferred to the Education Fund with no repayment required pursuant to Act number P.A. 85-0371 which became effective immediately when signed into law on September 11, 1987; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of this transfer from the Working Cash Fund to the Education Fund will be used in meeting the ordinary and necessary expenditures of the Community College District No. 507; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to permanently transfer the interest earned in the Working Cash Fund of eighty-seven thousand eight hundred ninety-one dollars and 33/100 (\$87,891.33) to the Education Fund to meet and defray such necessary expenses and liabilities of said Fund for the Fiscal Year 2018 beginning July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 507, Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign and Ford, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Treasurer of Community College District No. 507 be, and he/she is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the District, to permanently transfer the interest earnings in the amount of eighty-seven thousand eight hundred ninety-one dollars and 33/100 (\$87,891.33) from the Working Cash Fund to the Education Fund to meet and defray the ordinary and necessary expenses of said Fund for Fiscal Year 2018. SUMMARY: The proposed FY2019 budget is being submitted to you this

evening. An operational budget of \$16,636,020 is recommended. This is approximately 3.7% more than the FY2018 Operating budget. With the adoption of a FY19 budget at the state level, the College has been able to move forward by investing in Human Resources to maintain quality student service and provide training needed to meet

the employment demands of the community.

Depending on the fluctuation in the Equalized Assessed Valuation, the tax levy rate is anticipated to be approximately 61.51 cents. The current rate is 62.55 cents. From FY98 through FY01, the rate was 66

cents.

Expenditures in the Board Restricted Fund support contingencies for

one-time expenditures that may occur.
