MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING of December 13, 2018

On December 13, 2018, the Board of Trustees of Community College District 507, in the Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign, and Ford in the State of Illinois, met in regular session in the Board Room, Vermilion Hall Room 302 at Danville Area Community College.

ITEM 1: CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dave Harby called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

ITEM 2: PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Ms. Haley Jo Hendrickson, Presidential Scholar, led the Board and those in attendance in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

ITEM 3: ROLL CALL

Others present: President Dr. Stephen Nacco, Board Secretary Kerri Thurman, Dave Kietzmann, Tammy Betancourt, Jill Cranmore, Mike Cunningham, Stacy Ehmen, Jerry Davis, Laura Hensgen, Chris Cornell, Dick Brazda, Arthur Cronkhite, Travis Winkler, Cristina Oakley, Tishauna Fletcher, Marissa Uplinger, and Haley Jo Hendrickson.

ITEM 4: ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mr. Harby asked if there were any changes requested to the agenda. With no changes requested, upon motion by Dr. Serfoss, and a second by Mr. Hill, the agenda was approved as presented. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

ITEM 5: RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Dr. Nacco introduced the following members of the Administrative Council: Dave Kietzmann, Executive Vice President of Instruction and Student Services; Tammy Betancourt, Vice President, Finance/Chief Financial Officer; Jill Cranmore, Vice President, Human Resources; Mike Cunningham, Vice President, Administrative Services; and Stacy Ehmen, Dean, Student Services. Also present: Jerry Davis, Davis & Delanois; Laura Hensgen, Director, Continuing Education; Chris Cornell, Administrative Assistant/Graphics Specialist; Dick Brazda, VITA; Arthur Cronkhite; Travis Winkler, Cross Country Coach; Cristina Oakley, Tishauna Fletcher, and Marissa Uplinger, Cross Country Team Members; and Haley Jo Hendrickson, Presidential Scholar.

Media present: None.

ITEM 6: RECOGNITION OF MEN'S AND WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY TEAMS

Mr. Travis Winkler, Cross Country Coach, introduced Ms. Cristina Oakley, Ms. Tishauna Fletcher, and Ms. Marissa Uplinger. He noted the team members had a challenging year, vet persevered through difficult times.

Dr. Nacco and the Trustees thanked Mr. Winkler and the Cross Country team members for attending the meeting and for representing the College.

ITEM 7: CONTINUING EDUCATION REPORT

Ms. Laura Hensgen presented to the Board. She noted that it's once again tax season and the College plans to participate in the Voluntary Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program again this year. DACC has been involved with VITA since 2011. The current sites available for VITA are: DACC Campus, DACC Village Mall, Community Action, Georgetown, and Hoopeston. She reported that 902 tax returns were filed by VITA volunteers in the 2018 tax season for a total of \$881,479 in refunds.

Mr. Dick Brazda, VITA Volunteer Coordinator, expressed appreciation for the cooperation from DACC over the years. He noted there were approximately 20 volunteers last year whose returns that were submitted experienced a 93% accuracy rate.

Ms. Hensgen also shared that 30 trips (526 participants), 19 Lunch and Learns (319 participants), and 42 College for Kids offerings (232 participants) were offered to the community.

The Board and Dr. Nacco thanked Ms. Hensgen for her report and for her leadership of community education.

Ms. Tammy Betancourt gave a financial update to the Board. The Financial Statement of Revenue and Expenditures ending November 30, 2018 was included in the Board agenda book.

A request was made to remove Item 13C – Human Resources Report for discussion. Upon motion by Mr. Wolfe, and a second by Ms. Cherry, the Board approved the remaining items on the Consent Agenda. The motion passed by roll call vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

There was discussion regarding the proposed increase for student workers employed in the Child Development Center. It was proposed that the effective date of the increase be December 15 versus December 1. Upon motion by Mr. Black, and a second by Mr. Wolfe, the Board approved the increase for student workers employed in the Child Development Center effective December 1. The motion passed by roll call vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

ITEM 13: NEW BUSINESS A. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF TRAVEL EXPENDITURES FOR TRUSTEES

Per Public Law 99-0604, known as the "Local Government Travel Expense Control Act," travel expenses for members of the Board of Trustees must be approved at an open meeting of the Board.

A total of \$509.03 was expended for travel expenditures for trustees over the last month for the ICCTA Seminar for Mr. Greg Wolfe and for the AFP Awards Ceremony for Mr. Dave Harby.

Upon motion by Mr. Hill, and a second by Mr. Black, the Board approved the travel expenses as listed. The motion passed by roll call vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

B. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE

Our annual Workers Compensation Insurance is scheduled to expire December 31, 2018. Premiums for this insurance are determined by our estimated annual payroll, experience mod rate, and Foreign Terrorism and Domestic Terrorism coverage.

The January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018 premium to Zenith Insurance for workers compensation insurance was \$52,886.00. On behalf of Danville Area Community College, ONI Risk Partners requested quotes from other insurance underwriters. Workers compensation insurance premiums are paid using Tort Funds.

Upon motion by Mr. Wolfe, and a second by Mr. Hill, the Board approved the quote from Zenith Insurance in the amount of \$52,361.00 for Workers Compensation Insurance for coverage from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. The motion passed by roll call vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

C. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF BIDS FOR BREMER THEATER SOUND SYSTEM REPLACEMENT

Bids were advertised for the replacement of the Bremer Theater sound system. This project consists of furnishing all materials, components, and labor necessary to provide a complete and operational system. The project was approved on the FY-19 Capital Equipment list and funding will be through Tech Equipment Bonds.

Upon motion by Mr. Black, and a second by Dr. Serfoss, the Board approved the low base bid of \$43,750.00 from Thompson Electronics to replace the Bremer Theater sound system. The motion passed by roll call vote: 7 yeas, 0 nays.

D. BOARD CONSIDERATION OF REVISING FEES IN THE CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Our Child Development Center continues to be a center of excellence for social, emotional, physical, and intellectual development of a child. The Center recently received the Silver Circle of Quality designation from ExceleRate Illinois for the third time—a three-year honor that they have earned for seven straight years. This is not only a distinguished award that recognizes the excellent quality of care the Center provides, it qualifies the Center to receive a "quality add-on if serving children through IDHS Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)."

The Center also provides an environment for observation and training for our DACC students enrolled in Early Childhood Education, Education Transfer classes, Nursing, and College Express programs. Maintaining this level of quality service requires staffing and supply resources which continue to increase in cost.

Therefore, we are proposing that the rates be increased effective January 1, 2019 to help offset rising costs related to wages, benefits, food costs, and instructional supplies. The last fee rate increase was 4 ½ years ago in July of 2014. With the proposed rate changes, the Center will remain competitive with other providers in the area.

This Contract is made and entered into, by and between **Thomas Carey** (hereinafter referred to as the "Employee") and the Board of Trustees, Danville Area Community College, No. 507 (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"). The Board and the Employee hereby voluntarily agree as follows:

- I. WITNESSETH, that in consideration of an annual base salary for **Fiscal Year (2018-2019)** of **\$48,800.00** less any legal authorized deductions, including but not limit to required SURS deduction paid by the employee, said Employee agrees to well and faithfully perform the duties of **Data Analyst** and such other duties connected with Community College District No. 507 as may be assigned by the Danville Area Community College Board or its duly authorized representative. For each full month of employment such salary will be paid in semi-monthly installments on the pay period dates as established and published by the Payroll Department. For each partial month of employment, payment will be prorated. It is understood that as an administrative employee, you will serve at the pleasure of the Danville Area Community College Board of Trustees.
- II. That in exchange for the foregoing consideration and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Contract, the Board and the Employee Hereby Further Agree as follows:
 - A. That this term shall commence on the 1st day of February, 2019, and terminate on the 30th day of June 2019, and shall include all the service days designated on the official College calendar as it now appears or may hereafter be amended, that occur on or within these two dates.
 - B. That there shall be deducted from the salary of said Employee an amount equal to the pay for one day of service for each day of service during the employment agreement term in which it is not performed, unless absence from duty with pay is specifically authorized by Board Policy, or unless absence from duty is occasioned by illness or injury qualifying as sick leave within the provisions of the Board's established sick leave policy.
 - C. That if said Employee resigns, is lawfully discharged, or is released before the completion of said term, final settlement shall be made so the total amount which the Employee shall have received shall be an amount equal to the product of the number of days of service multiplied by the amount considered as pay for one day of service. Days of service actually performed shall be deemed to include sick leave days and authorized absence days for which pay has been authorized prior to the date of release, discharge, or termination.
 - D. That by acceptance of this Contract the Employee hereby agrees to be governed by the policies of the Danville Area Community College Board to perform the duties as assigned by authorized College Administrators.

SUMMARY: The College is required to have a resolution adopted by the Board to allow the transfer of monies from the Working Cash Fund to the Educational Fund and Operations and Maintenance Fund. This resolution authorizes funds to be transferred as needed to meet the payment due dates for expenditures incurred in these funds when the revenue is not received in time to meet the cash outflow requirements. This transfer also avoids the issuance of tax anticipation warrants.

The transaction is considered an internal loan and must be repaid to the Working Cash Fund within one calendar year since the intent is not to abolish the balance in this fund. The majority of the funds utilized to pay the loan will be from the collection of tax revenue and student tuition with no reliance on state funding.

The timing of this resolution avoids having a negative cash balance at the end of the fiscal year (June 30). This resolution is requested annually and meets the requirements of ICCB and the College Auditors.

<u>ACTION</u> REQUESTED:

May we ask the Board to consider approval of the resolution of transfer of monies from the Working Cash Fund to the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund.

MODIFIED RESOLUTION FOR TRANSFER OF MONIES FROM THE WORKING CASH FUND TO THE OPERATING FUND (EDUCATION FUND AND THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE FUND) FOR 2019

WHEREAS, Community College District No. 507, Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign and Ford, State of Illinois, has heretofore duly established a Working Cash Fund, pursuant to the Illinois Public Community College Act; and,

WHEREAS, monies may be transferred from the Working Cash Fund to the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund in order to provide monies with which to meet ordinary and necessary disbursements for educational and maintenance fund purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the monies to be transferred to the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund, shall be disbursed in anticipation of the collection of taxes in excess of any outstanding tax anticipation warrants; or in anticipation of the receipt by the District of monies from the State, Federal Government, or other sources; and,

WHEREAS, taxes levied for educational purposes and operations and maintenance purposes, when collected, shall be applied first to the payment of any outstanding warrants and to interest thereon, and then to the reimbursement of the Working Cash Fund; and,

WHEREAS, monies received from the State or Federal Government and other sources shall be used in reimbursing the Working Cash Fund to the extent transfers therefrom were made in anticipation thereof; and,

WHEREAS, there is presently insufficient monies in the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund of the District, to meet and defray ordinary and necessary expenses of the District lawfully payable from said fund; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to transfer <u>five million, four hundred twenty-</u><u>nine thousand seven hundred twenty-two dollars and 79/100 (\$5,429,722.79)</u> from the Working Cash Fund to the Operating Fund and utilized in either or both of the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund to meet and defray such necessary expenses and liabilities of said Funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 507, Counties of Vermilion, Edgar, Iroquois, Champaign and Ford, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Treasurer of Community College District No. 507 be, and he/she is hereby, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the District, to transfer the amount of <u>five million</u>, four hundred twenty-nine thousand seven hundred twenty-two <u>dollars and 79/100 (\$5,429,722.79)</u> from the Working Cash Fund to the to the Operating Fund and utilized in either or both the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund to meet and defray the ordinary and necessary expenses of said Funds.

SECTION 2: That the Working Cash Fund shall be reimbursed from the following sources:

(a)	Four million seven hundred thousand dollars	(<u>\$</u>

(b) <u>One million nine hundred thousand dollars</u> <u>and 00/100</u> (\$<u>1,900,000.00</u>) Dollars from the State of Illinois.

(d) <u>Seven million dollars and 00/100</u> (\$ 7,000,000.00) from other sources. Student tuition and fees.

SECTION 3: That the entire amount of personal property replacement taxes and property taxes extended, or which the Board estimates will be extended, for this year by each County Clerk upon the books of the collectors of state and county taxes within the District in anticipation of the collection of all or part of which this transfer is to be made is <u>Five million two hundred seventeen thousand and 00/100 (\$5,217,00.00)</u> Dollars.

SECTION 4: That the aggregate amount of warrants heretofore issued in anticipation of the collection of such taxes under this Act, together with the amount of interest accrued and which the Board of Trustees estimates will accrue thereon, is <u>NONE (\$ NONE)</u> Dollars.

SECTION 5: That the amount of monies which the Board of Trustees estimates will be derived for this year from the State and Federal Government or other sources, in anticipation of the receipt of all or part of such transfer is to be made as follows:

(a) From the State Government:

One million nine hundred thousand and no/100 (\$1,900,000.00) Dollars

(b) From the Federal Government:			
NONE	(\$	NONE) Dollars

(c) From other sources: Student Tuition and Fees Seven million and no/100 (\$ 7,000,000.00) Dollars

SECTION 6: That the aggregate amount of monies heretofore transferred from the Working Cash Fund to the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and Operations and Maintenance Fund, in anticipation of the collection of such taxes or of the receipt of such other monies from such sources is <u>five million, four hundred twenty-nine thousand seven hundred twenty-two dollars and 79/100 (\$5,429,722.79).</u>

SECTION 7: That the amount of monies which the District Treasurer is hereby directed to transfer from the Working Cash Fund to the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund, in anticipation of the collection of taxes levied for the year, together with the aggregate amount of anticipated tax warrants heretofore drawn against such taxes and the amount of interest accrued and estimated to accrue thereon, and the aggregate amount of such transfers heretofore made in anticipation of the collection of such taxes, shall not exceed 90 percent of the actual or estimated amount of such taxes extended or to be extended as set forth in this Resolution.

SECTION 8: That the amount of monies which the District Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer from the Working Cash Fund to the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund, for this year from the State, Federal Government, or from other sources, together with the aggregate amount heretofore transferred in anticipation of the receipt of such monies, shall not exceed the total amount it is estimated will be received from such source or sources. SECTION 9: That monies transferred from the Working Cash Fund to the Operating Fund, which includes the Education Fund and the Operations and Maintenance Fund, shall be used so as to avoid, whenever possible, the issuance of Tax Anticipation Warrants.

SECTION 10: That this modified Resolution shall be in full force and effective beginning January 2019, its original passage.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: We are recommending that the Board approve temporary tuition waivers for any shortfall in the tuition reimbursement that the DACC Foundation provides for the Presidential Scholars Program during FY 2018-19.

The DACC Foundation's corpus for funding the Presidential Scholars program has dwindled to approximately \$700,000, which represents the combined total of the Brittingham and Front Line scholarship funds. With the cost of reimbursing tuition for 40 Presidential Scholars totaling approximately \$120,000 annually for 20 first-year Scholars and 20 second-year Scholars, the existing fund would not be able to sustain the program in future years.

The DACC Foundation will launch a fundraising campaign on April 1, 2019, with a chief objective being to increase the corpus for the Presidential Scholarship program to a minimum \$2.3 million, which would then generate at least 5 percent annually in investment revenue and the required \$120,000 each year to fund the program in perpetuity.

Waiving unfunded Presidential Scholars tuition would be a stop-gap measure in 2018-19 and helps give the Foundation time to reach the desired target for fully funding the Presidential Scholars Program. The approximate total waivers for 2018-19 would be \$85,000, with the Foundation generating the remaining \$35,000 from investments of the current \$700,000 corpus.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: In order for the application for the Army Reserve Center to be submitted, the applicant's governing body must provide approval in the form of the Resolution attached. The Resolution must also authorize an individual to expend any necessary funds.

<u>ACTION</u>: May we ask the Board to approve the Resolution regarding submission of an application for Public Benefit Allowance Acquisition of Surplus Federal Real Property for Education Purposes.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, certain real property owned by the United States of America, located in the County of Vermilion, State of Illinois, has been declared surplus to the needs of the Federal government and is subject to assignment for disposal for educational purposes by the Secretary of Education, under the provisions of §203(k) of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended ("Act"), 40 U.S.C. §550(c), and rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, more particularly described as follows:

The Army Reserve Center is located at 2408 East Main Street, Danville, Illinois 61832. The property was built in 1958 and consists of two buildings with a lot size of 3.53 acres. The administrative/office building is a two-story 22,878 square foot (approx.) concrete block structure with a brick exterior finish and mostly concrete and sheetrock interior walls. The garage/storage building is a one-story 4,356 square foot (approx.) structure that has brick exterior walls with concrete block interior walls. The site has a paved parking area and is enclosed by a chain-link fence topped with barbed wire.

WHEREAS, Danville Area Community College District No. 507 needs and can utilize said property for educational purposes in accordance with the requirements of said Act and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder of which this Board is fully informed, including commitments regarding use and time within such use shall commence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Danville Area Community College District No. 507 shall make application to the Secretary of Education for, and secure the transfer to it, of the above-mentioned property for said use upon and subject to such exceptions, reservations, terms, covenants, agreements, conditions and restrictions as the Secretary of Education, or his authorized representative may require in connection with the disposal of said property under said Act and rules and regulations issued thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Danville Area Community College District No. 507 has legal authority and is willing and is in a position financially and otherwise to assume immediate care and maintenance of the property, and that Danville Area Community College District No. 507, Dr. Stephen Nacco, is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of Danville Area Community College District No. 507 to do and perform any and all acts and things which may be necessary to carry out the foregoing resolution including the preparing, making and filing of plans, applications, reports and other documents; the execution, acceptance, delivery and recordation of agreements, deeds and other instruments pertaining to the transfer of said property; and the payment of any and all sums necessary on account of the purchase price thereof including fees or costs incurred in connection with the transfer of said property for surveys, title searches, real estate appraisals, recordation of instruments or costs associated with escrow arrangements; together with any payments necessary by virtue of nonuse or deferral of use of the property. If the applicant is unable to place the property into use (or determines that a deferral of use should occur), IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that Danville Area Community College District No. 507 will pay to the U.S. Department of Education for each month of nonuse beginning twelve (12) months after the date of the deed, or thirty-six (36) months where construction or

major renovation is contemplated, the sum of $1/360^{\text{th}}$ of the then current fair market value of the property for each month of nonuse.

If submission of the Application for Public Benefit Allowance Acquisition of Surplus Federal Real Property for Education Purposes is approved, a copy of the application and standard deed conditions will be filed with the permanent minutes of the Board.
