- 1. Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) Update
 - a. Bob discussed the KPI #1B The Number of Community College Degrees and Certificates Awarded as Compared to Credit Hours
 - Looks for a trend between a decrease in credit hours to coincide for a decrease in degrees/certificates
 - ii. The chart could be more helpful if we show a number of credits instead of headcount when viewing enrollment
 - 1. Bob's office will create a sample of this information and present it at the next meeting
 - iii. Andrew agrees that the logic behind changing this is there, but we don't want to spend too much time rehashing all of the data
 - b. It's always good to spend time looking through these in small groups to just discuss what we think are problem areas
 - i. Group 1 (KPI #1 & #2)
 - 1. KPI#1
 - a. Our overall average is considerably less than our peer colleges
 - Kaskaskia and Highland have both been creating short-term certificates over the last few years while DACC has not because of gainful employment
 - Our associate degree completion rates not that far off from peer colleges, so this shows this discrepancy
 - c. Our changes in certificates could have been due to vacancies in the DOC
 - 2. KPI #2
 - a. At-Risk students are showing increases in completions, but this is only up to FY 11
 - ii. Group 2 (KPI #3 & #4)
 - 1. KPI #3
 - a. Focused mostly on how the chart is set up
 - i. Jessica agrees with the issues and will fix it
 - 2. KPI #4

- a. A lot of information in one area, so maybe there could be a better way to show this information
- b. The gap between Pell vs. Non-Pell is increasing in developmental classes

iii. Group 3 (KPI #5 & #6)

- 1. Page 17 KPI #5 Overall and Gatekeeper Course Completion
 - a. Change the name of the graph and add a trend line for gatekeeper courses to show the comparison
 - b. Saw a lot of positive trends in gatekeeper courses, but part-time students are not showing as positive of an increase
 - c. Overall Success Rates

2. KPI #6 Momentum Points

- a. Some of this information was pulled from faulty data
- b. Progression and Completion team created to focus on this area

iv. Group 4 (KPI #7 & #8)

1. KPI#7

- a. Old numbers, because this information hasn't been updates by ICCB
- b. Drastic change in FY 2011 could be due to the Fall 2007 students and the Colleague conversion

2. KPI #8

2. Math Placement Cut Scores

- a. A Math Placement Scores Task Force met to update mat cut scores and testing policies and creating multiple measures
- b. Bob presented a chart that shows recommended math score changes
- c. Have added a component where students can use high school math courses to register for classes
 - i. Not being done too many places in the country, but it's being considered a best practice
- Some of the changes to these may increase sections for DEVM 100 but not too drastically
- e. English (or English and Reading) will be done next fall with the hope of being on a 3-year cycle
