“Moving Data to Strategies” Planning Session

I. Why are we doing this? (Event Purpose)

Cindy wanted to talk about the “Moving Data to Strategies” retreat. It was decided at the last meeting to hold this retreat during the October In-Service. It was also decided that the Leadership team would introduce the topic and plans at the August In – Service. The team wanted to give instructors an opportunity to look at the data, see what it is telling them and then come up with strategies to help move the needle of student success. This “retreat” will also be presented at the part time faculty academy. The plan is to get some of the full time people participating in it to come back and talk to the part time faculty.

II. When are we doing this? (Faculty and staff in-service and October In-Service)

Time will be allotted during Carla Boyd’s session at the August In-Service to introduce the topic and information to the staff. Most of the activity will be done during October in-service.

III. Who will be involved? (Full and Part-time Faculty Members, Faculty Presenter’s/Facilitators, etc.)

At the previous meeting, members had talked about using faculty who have seen increases in their courses to talk about what they are doing. It was suggested that Ryan Stone and Amber Anderson be asked to present. Also, it was decided to ask faculty if they would like to present and if we don’t get many responses back, then email the Deans for “nominations.” Laura suggested it also might be nice to highlight a part time faculty member. Different data reports will be requested of Jessica, including part time instructor success rates, etc. Cindy will ask Jessica for this information.

IV. What do we need for the event? (Data, Materials, etc.)

Cindy will talk to Jessica about getting the information needed. Cindy thinks that a part of the KPI packets from the Data team could be useful. It was decided to give faculty members overall numbers instead of distributing individual’s information. Also, it was suggested to distribute the information ahead of time so they know what to do and pay attention to at the In-Service. Wendy also suggested providing the comparison data of where we started in Atd and then what the data looks like today.

Wendy noted that most classes did improve, although some have not. Other people are trying new things, and it is showing in their class. That would be a very powerful slide as well.

V. Next Steps

What needs to be ready for August in-service.

- Ask Andrew to present some of the KPIs (a sampling of the data team data)(highlights)
- Somebody needs to introduce the October retreat. Wendy or Stephanie Loveless can do this and present the information in about 10 minutes.
- Carla will be at least an hour for her Framework on Poverty presentation
- Ask about data that they (faculty members) would want.
- At the part-time faculty academy, a shorter version will be presented and lead instructors will be asked to attend
