- c. DACC has received an invitation to attend an Achieving the Dream data summit in North Carolina. Dr. Jacobs and Stacy Ehmen will attend.
- d. The ATD Equity and Inclusion sub-team is planning a student focus group for the fall semester. Students who have attended DACC for at least 1 year and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 will be invited to attend. Discussion will center on what strategies have helped students be successful in college. Some participants may be asked to serve on a panel to present at the spring in-service.
- e. The ATD Teaching and Learning sub-team is working on revising evaluations for the Teaching Excellence Academy. The academy will be scheduled three times per year, during in-service.
