1. 2.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).

Admission Criteria to the Teacher Education Program

(Admission to the University does not guarantee admission to this program.)

1. Apply 1 year prior to the term you wish to start.
2. An overall GPA of at least 2.75 (4.0 scale).
3. Completion of English 101 and 102 with a grade of C or better.

To become a licensed/certified teacher in the State of Illinois, an individual must pass at least three state exams:

1. As of June 30, 2019, the Test of Basic Skills is no longer required to obtain an educator licensure. This includes the SAT and ACT exams. Students will still need to pass the edTPA and content tests in the relevant subject and grade they intend to teach.

4. Recommended courses include: ARTS 105, ARTS 115, MUSI 115
5. Recommended courses include: PHIL 101, PHIL 102, PHIL 103, LITR 122, LITR 113, or LITR 114

6. SIU recommends taking MUSI 120, SOCY 225, LITR 111, LITR 121, or LITR 122 to fulfill their multicultural studies requirement. These could also be used as a Humanities Elective.
