The reason for the proposed issuance of the bonds is to pay claims against the District, being the District's outstanding General Obligation Debt Certificates (Limited Tax), Series 2025A.

These funds will be used to upgrade technology and purchase equipment to provide state-of-theart capital resources in our classrooms and supporting services. To meet the principal and interest obligations of this debt, the College must pursue issuing Technology and Equipment Funding Bonds in the amount of \$1,500,000.
